**INSTRUCTIONS FOR CORRECTIONS ON THE LIST OF LIGHTS**  
**(ED. 2008)**

1. The corrections (changes, additions, deletes) of List of Lights publication included in the middle (No IV) of the monthly editions of the Notices to Mariners and are given in columns , as following :
  - a. **First Column:** The number of the Hellenic List of Lights (ΑΕΦ), which is affected by the correction, is recorded. If the recorded number does not exist in the List of lights, then it is a new one and its characteristics must be recorded in the according between the ΑΕΦ, column of the List of Lights
  - b. **Other Columns:**
    - (1) - - With two dashes are marked the columns which are not affected, while in those that are affected are written the data which must be recorded, deleting at the same time all the old ones
    - (2) With ***italic letters*** are given instructions in order to cover special occasions (delete of column or all the columns of the cancelled light).
  
2. It is recommended that small extent corrections must be recorded by hand, while additions of new “ΑΕΦ” or corrections of greater extend will be cut out and pasted on the List of Lights
